




TSCHS provides courses that are not bound by <u>TIME and LOCATION</u>, allowing for the attainment of the OSSD in Canada.



OSSD Requirements

30 Credits (18 Compulsory Credits + 12 Elective Credits)

Each course is considered as 1 credit. However, Civics (CHV2O) and Career (GLC2O) are considered as 0.5 credits.

40 Hours of Community Involvement Activities

When submitting documents provided by TSCHS after volunteering, they are acknowledged

OSSLT* (Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test)

The OSSLT is a mandatory literacy test required for 10th-grade students attending high school in Ontario to obtain the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD). This test assesses students' minimum literacy standards. If a student fails twice, they are given two opportunities for a retest. Alternatively, in the 12th grade, they can take a course called OLC4O as a replacement.
